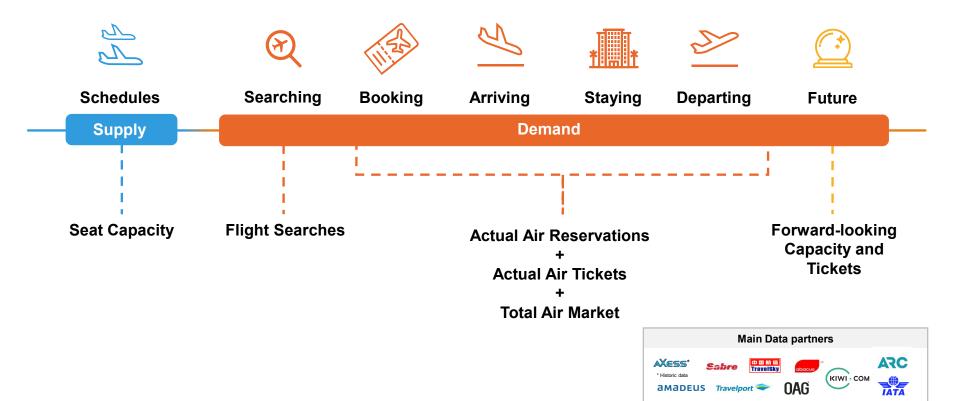

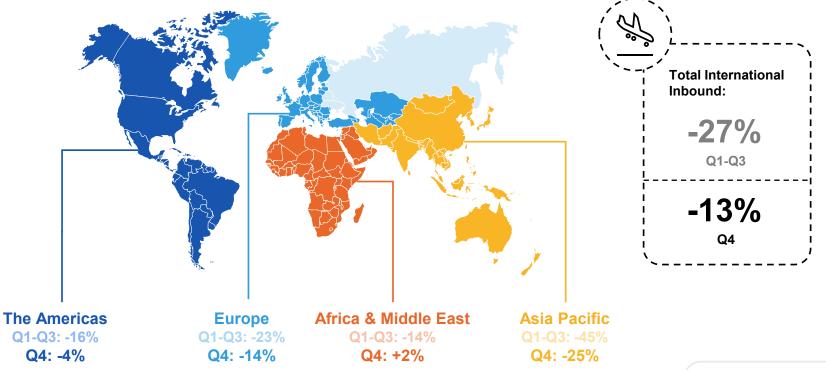




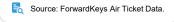
#### Asia Pacific's Inbound Travel Accelerates, Claims the Q4 Recovery Speed Crown



International worldwide arrivals in 2023; vs 2019 levels









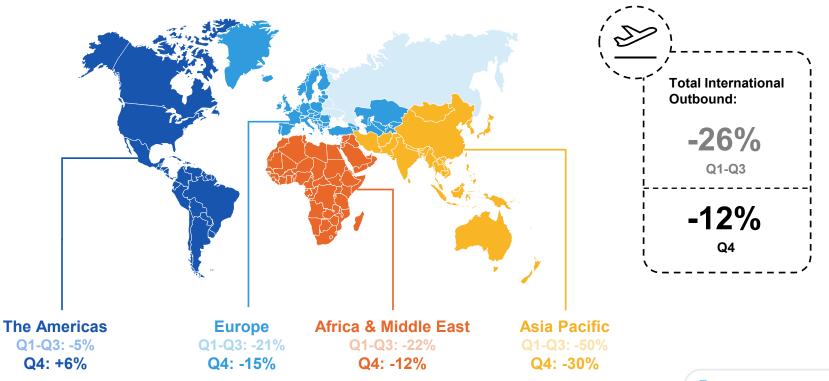




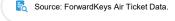
#### **Outbound Travel in the Americas Takes the Lead**

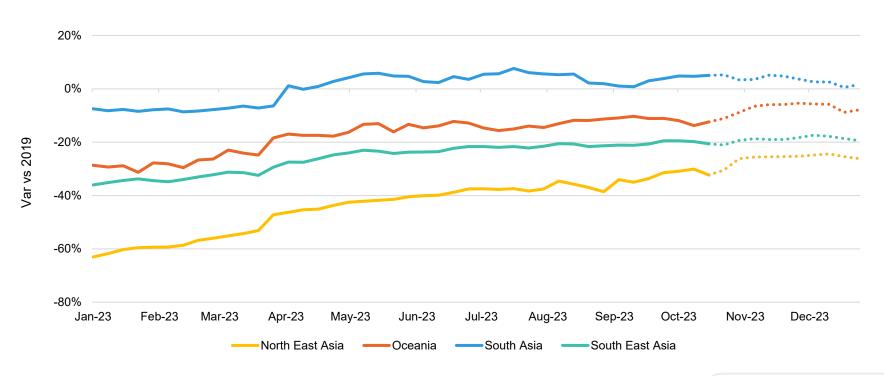




#### The Significance of Restored Air Supply

International arrivals in Asia Pacific in Q4 2023; vs 2019 levels













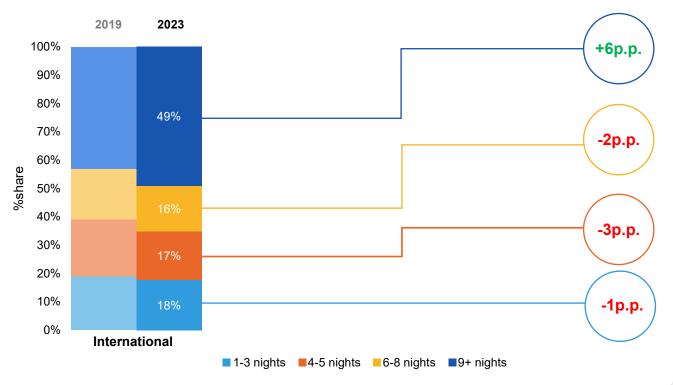


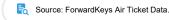


#### **Tourists are Staying for Longer**



International arrivals in APAC in Q4 2023, as of 7 Oct; var vs 2019







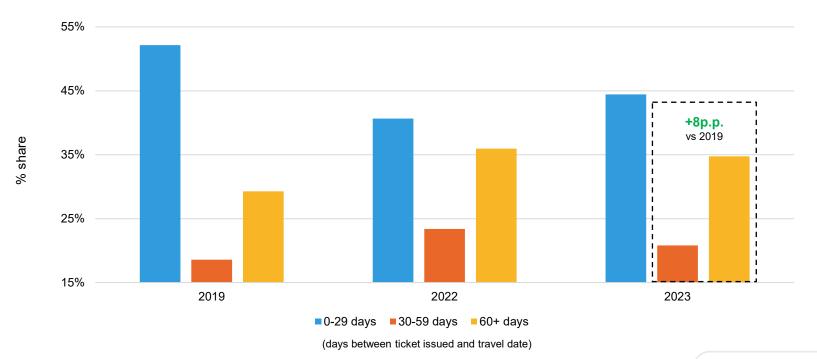


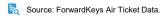


#### **Lead-times: Trips are Booked with Greater Anticipation**

International arrivals to APAC in Q3, segmented by lead-time; vs 2019









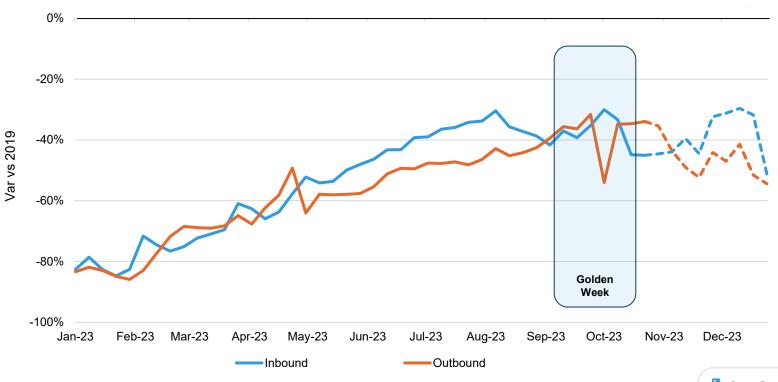


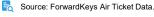


#### **Inbound and Outbound Travel in China are on Upward Trends**

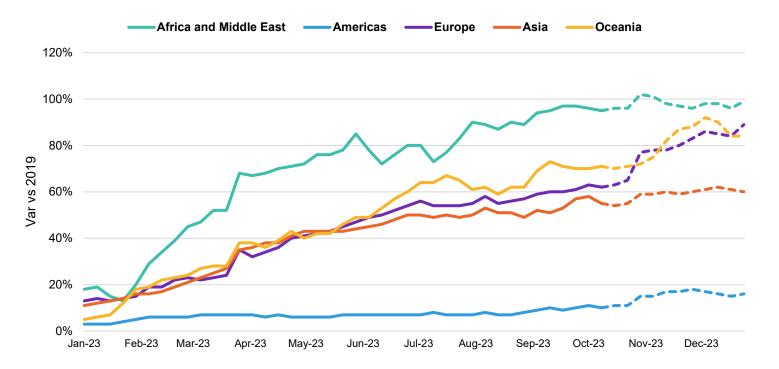






## Flight connectivity to China: Limited in the Americas, Markedly Enhanced in Europe 💓

Scheduled Seat Capacity for departing flights from China in 2023, as of 16 Oct; vs 2019









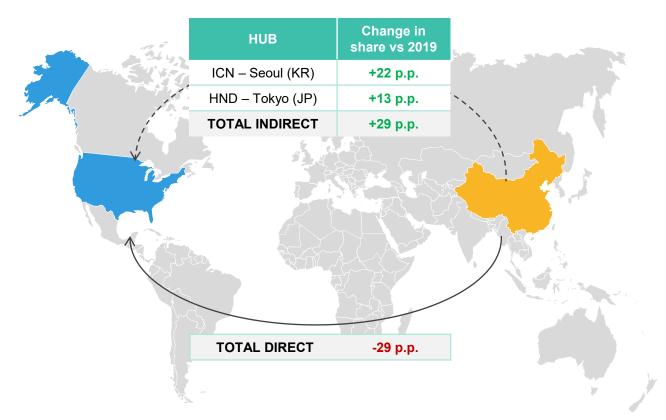

Arrivals from China in the US in Q3 2023; vs same period in 2019







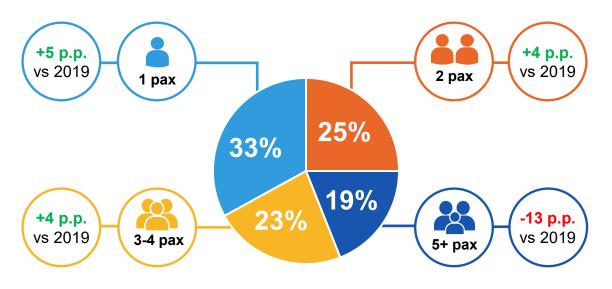




#### The Changing Preference of Smaller Size Travel

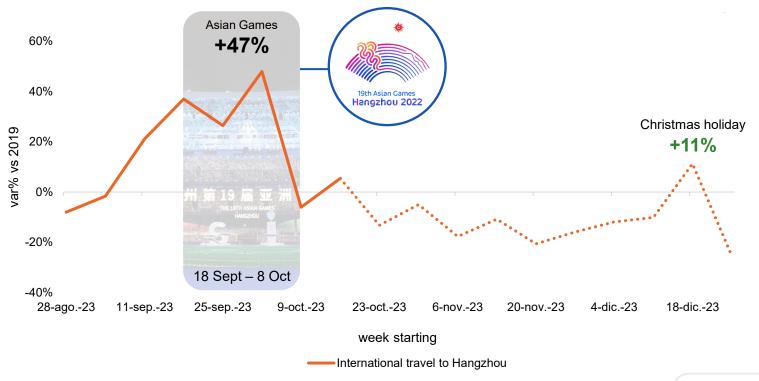

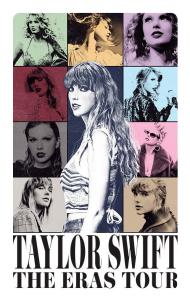
