

New Delhi (Half Day Tour / 4 Hrs approx)

07:45 hrs: Depart the hotel in the shuttle bus and drive past Safdarjung Tomb (1753 A.D)

followed by a visit to the Qutub Minar - 72 meters high and one of the perfect towers of the Persian World. Nearby, amidst the ruins of the Quwut-ul-islam Mosque stands the iron pillar which has stood the vagaries of the weather and not

rusted over 1500 years.

10:00 hrs: Depart Qutab Minar and proceed to Humayun's Tomb (1565 A.D) appropriately

called the predecessor of Taj Mahal.

11:30 hrs: After the visit to Humayun's Tomb proceed for an orientation tour through New

Delhi which includes the Embassy area (Diplomatic Enclave), War Memorial Arch

(India Gate) and Government Buildings (1921-30 A.D)

12:30 hrs: On the way to back to the hotel, drive past Jantar-Mantar – the Astronomical

Observatory (1717 A.D) and through Connaught Place - New Delhi's main shopping centre. (Buses might not be able to enter the Connaught Place area, just
